(As in the macrocosm, so in the microcosm)



West Tuscumbia, Alabama, she lost her sight and her hearing after a bout of illness at the age of 19 months. Her astrology chart is given below.



- Moon: Breast, mind, head, chest, kidney, water in body, heart.
- Mars: Blood, marrow, genitals, rectum, veins, head, female organs, Fore-head, nose vitality, pregnancy problems, blood pressure, emotions, anger, aggression, menstrual cycle irregularities
- Mercury: Tongue, arms, mouth, chest, spinal cord, gall bladder, nerves, skin, memory.
- Jupiter: Fat, kidney, liver, tongue, right ear, higher mental plane, diabetes.
- Saturn: All types of joints, particularly knee cap and knee joints, arthritis, muscular pains.
- Venus: Eye trouble, pigmentation causing ugliness, problem of teeth, legs, hair, bones, sweat glands, limbs, fatigue, weakness, ageing, wrinkles, piles.
- Rahu: Bad teeth, dental problems, excretory organs, genitals.
- Ketu: Feet, anus, impotency.
